- Connect homeless individuals with trained volunteer mentors to help them move into a more successful future.

•EDUCATION & TRAINING

- Education and job readiness training for opportunities with community employment partners.

- Assist in emergency shelter, transitional and permanent housing in cooperation with public and private housing agencies.



The Problem

The National Alliance to End Homelessness reports that there are 552,830 people experiencing homelessness on any given night in America. Thirty-three percent (33%) are families with children. Forty-eight percent (48%) are unable to work.

Recent figures indicate that over 31,000 Floridians are homeless. According to the National Alliance to End Homelessness, on any given night, 1,400 people are unsheltered in Palm Beach County. Thirty-three percent (33%) are families with children. Forty-eight percent (48%) are unable to work. "Homelessness," states the General Assembly of the United Nations, "is a human rights crisis that demands an urgent global response."
